

CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL COLORADO MIGHTY MILLIONS RAFFLE 2020

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. WHAT IS THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL COLORADO MIGHTY MILLIONS RAFFLE?

A. Children's Hospital Colorado Mighty Millions Raffle is a community fundraising initiative. The raffle is an opportunity for the public to help raise funds for Children's Colorado by buying a ticket for a chance to win incredible prizes. Net proceeds raised are used for Children's Colorado's greatest needs, providing the hospital with resources to care for its young patients. A Children's Hospital Colorado Mighty Millions Raffle ticket purchase is not a charitable donation, but rather an opportunity to support the hospital through participation in a gaming event where ticket buyers have a chance to win prizes.

Q. HOW DOES CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL COLORADO FOUNDATION USE RAFFLE TICKET PROCEEDS?

A. Children's Hospital Colorado is the only comprehensive nonprofit children's hospital in the region. Every dollar raised from the community is used to further the hospital's mission of caring for and curing children through providing high-quality care, education, research and advocacy.

The net proceeds of the raffle, after prizes are awarded and expenses are paid, support Children's Hospital Colorado's Children's Fund. The Children's Fund is used for Children's Colorado's greatest needs, allowing the hospital to improve the care offered to every child who comes through its doors. The hospital strives to provide each child — as well as each child's family — with the best possible healthcare experience and outcome. The Children's Fund helps to do just that.

Q. HOW DO I PURCHASE MIGHTY MILLIONS RAFFLE TICKETS?

A. Tickets may be purchased online at MightyMillionsRaffle.com or by phone at 1-844-514-2126. Ticket purchases may be made only by credit card; cash and checks are not accepted.

Q. WHAT IS THE COST OF RAFFLE TICKETS?

A. Tickets are 1 for \$100 and packages of 3 tickets for \$250, 5 tickets for \$375 or the Mighty Pack for \$500 (includes 6 raffle tickets and 7 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar Add-On tickets).

Q. HOW MANY TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE 2020 MIGHTY MILLIONS RAFFLE?

A. A maximum of 125,000 Mighty Millions Raffle tickets are available for sale.

Q. HOW MANY RAFFLE TICKETS CAN I BUY?

A. You may buy as many raffle tickets as you like.

Q. WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE RAFFLE TICKETS?

A. Ticket buyers and holders must be at least 18 years of age and reside in the United States. A ticket may not be purchased or held by (1) an individual who is prohibited from purchasing or holding a ticket under applicable law or applicable U.S. federal law, or (2) the following individuals and members of their immediate family who reside at the same address: (a) Children's Hospital Colorado Foundation employees and members of the Children's Hospital Colorado Foundation Board of Trustees, (b) Children's Hospital Colorado senior executives and members of the Children's Hospital Colorado Board of Directors, and (c) the builder, designer and developer of the Grand Prize Showhome. A ticket may not be assigned or transferred to another individual. Persons who reside outside the United States may not purchase tickets.

Q. HOW ARE TICKET NUMBERS GENERATED?

A. Tickets are assigned numbers in the order in which they are processed. Tickets will be issued by email only.

Q. WHY CAN'T I BUY A TICKET BY MAIL OR IN PERSON AT A CHILDREN'S COLORADO LOCATION?

A. In order to streamline the raffle process and issue tickets to purchasers in a timely fashion, Mighty Millions Raffle tickets may be purchased by telephone and online only. Tickets are issued by email only.

Q. WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE AN EMAIL ADDRESS? CAN I STILL ORDER A TICKET?

A. Yes, you may still order a ticket; and if your payment is processed, your ticket numbers will be entered into all of the applicable prize draws. Tickets are issued by email only.

Q. IF I DON'T HAVE AN EMAIL ADDRESS AND DON'T KNOW MY TICKET NUMBERS, HOW CAN I FIND OUT IF I HAVE WON A PRIZE?

A. Initial prize notification letters are promptly sent to all prize winners by U.S. Mail and by email to the address provided by the purchaser. Prize draw results will also be posted promptly following draws at MightyMillionsRaffle.com.

Q. HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO RECEIVE MY TICKET?

A. If a valid payment is confirmed, a ticket number will be emailed immediately to the email address provided by the purchaser.

Q. IS MY TICKET PURCHASE TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

A. No. Raffle ticket purchases are not charitable donations and are not deductible for income tax purposes.

Q. WHAT IF I WANT A REFUND?

A. Mighty Millions Raffle Official Rules state that all ticket sales are final and that there are no refunds. Please ensure that you check your order information carefully before submitting your order.

Q. ARE RAFFLE WINNINGS CONSIDERED INCOME?

A. Yes, Raffle winnings are considered income by the Internal Revenue Service and are subject to federal and state income taxes and may be subject to state and local sales or use taxes. The Raffle will remit applicable federal income taxes, as required by the IRS to be withheld, for prizes valued at \$5,000 or more (net of the cost of the ticket). Bonus Cash is awarded for an amount equal to that required by the IRS to be withheld from gambling winnings. Any additional federal or state income tax will be the responsibility of the winner. Q. HOW MANY PRIZES ARE AWARDED?

A. 8,639 prizes will be awarded including the Grand Prize Showhome, vehicles, vacations, season tickets and more.

Q. WHY DO SOME PRIZES COME WITH BONUS CASH?

A. The Raffle awards Bonus Cash for all prizes with a contracted value of \$5,000 or more (net of the cost of the ticket). The Bonus Cash is part of the prize and is awarded for the amount of federal income tax that the Raffle is required to withhold on gambling winnings and to enhance the overall winning experience. The Bonus Cash will be remitted directly to the IRS on the winner's behalf. Any additional federal or state income tax will be the responsibility of the winner.

Q. HOW ARE THE PRIZE VALUES CALCULATED?

A. Advertised prize values are approximate retail values. Due to housing market fluctuations, the market value of the Grand Prize Showhome may increase or decrease over time. Neither the winner nor Children's Hospital Colorado is entitled to the difference, if any, between the stated and actual market value at the time a prize is awarded. Prize values include applicable sales taxes paid on the purchase of the prizes.

Q. ARE THE PRIZES DONATED?

A. No. All prizes are purchased by Children's Hospital Colorado Foundation.

Q. IF I WIN, DO I HAVE TO TAKE MY PRIZE OR CAN I TAKE CASH?

A. All prizes must be accepted as awarded. There are no cash substitutes, unless otherwise advertised. See [Rules](#) for more information.

Q. HOW ARE WINNERS NOTIFIED?

A. Winners are notified by U.S. Mail and email as to the prize they have won and how to claim the prize. Depending on the type of prize, there are various methods available to claim prizes in a timely manner.

Q. CAN SOMEONE WHO LIVES OUTSIDE COLORADO OR OVERSEAS BUY A TICKET?

A. Ticket purchasers must reside in the United States. Persons who reside outside the United States may not purchase tickets.

Q. WHEN DOES THE RAFFLE END?

A. The Raffle will end on the final ticket sales deadline, May 1, 2020 at midnight Mountain Time, or when all 125,000 tickets are sold.

Q. IF I WIN A PRIZE, AM I ELIGIBLE FOR OTHER DRAWS?

A. Yes, all tickets sold are included in all draws for which they are eligible. Winning tickets for all draws will be re-entered for all remaining draws, and therefore a ticket purchaser or holder could win more than one prize.

Q. ARE THE DRAWS AUDITED?

A. Yes. An independent auditor audits the draws.

Q. WHAT ARE MY ODDS OF WINNING?

A. The odds of winning a prize are 1 in 15. The odds of winning the Grand Prize Showhome are based on the number of tickets sold. If all tickets are sold, the odds of winning the Grand Prize are 1 in 125,000.

Q. DO I HAVE TO BE PRESENT AT A DRAW TO WIN?

A. No. Ticket holders do not need to be present at draws to win and are not required to have received their official tickets in order to be included in the draws.

Q. HOW ARE THE WINNERS NOTIFIED?

A. Each prize is awarded to the winning ticket holder, who is the individual named on the winning ticket. Prize notification letters are promptly sent to all prize winners by U.S. Mail and by email to the address provided by the purchaser. Prize draw results will be posted soon after the draws at MightyMillionsRaffle.com.

Q. HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO CLAIM MY PRIZE?

A. Winners who have not claimed their prizes within 20 days of the applicable draw date will be notified by U.S. Certified Mail, return receipt requested. The notice will include information regarding the prize won, a contact person's email and the time and manner by which the winner may claim the prize. If a winner fails to claim a prize within 30 days of receiving this notification, the Foundation may retain the prize.

Vacation winners must claim their prizes within 30 days of the draw date and must travel within one year of draw date.

Q. WHO BENEFITS FROM THIS RAFFLE?

A. The Mighty Millions Raffle benefits prize winners and the families who depend on Children's Colorado for expert pediatric health care.

Q. WHAT IS THE 100 DAYS OF WINNING CASH CALENDAR® ADD-ON?

A. 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-Ons are a way for Raffle purchasers to win cash prizes. The 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® awards \$2,000 each day over 100 consecutive days, with a total prize value of \$200,000. 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-ons are available only in conjunction with the purchase of a Mighty Millions Raffle ticket. 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® ticket prices are 1 for \$25, 3 for \$50 and 6 for \$75 or the Mighty Pack for \$500 (includes 6 Raffle tickets and 7 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-On tickets).

100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-On orders will not be accepted after an original Mighty Millions Raffle ticket purchase. Draws for the 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-On will take place on either April 22, 2020 or May 14, 2020 based on the applicable Mighty Millions Raffle draw scenario (see Draw Information, below). 100 Days of Winning Cash Calendar® Add-On winners will be posted daily at MightyMillionsRaffle.com from June 1 to September 8, 2020.

Q. IS THE MIGHTY MILLIONS RAFFLE LEGAL AND LEGITIMATE?

A. Yes. The Children's Hospital Colorado Mighty Millions Raffle is licensed by the Colorado Secretary of State Bingo-Raffles Division under Raffle License No. 2020-15011.

We do not rent, sell or trade our contact lists, but we may solicit charitable donations from Raffle buyers. Draw Information

***Draw Scenario 1**

All tickets sold by the Loyalty Prize Deadline of midnight Mountain Time, Feb. 28, 2020, will be eligible for Loyalty Prize Draws (5 prizes) on March 26, 2020. All tickets sold by the VIP Prize Deadline of midnight Mountain Standard Time, March 13, 2020, will be eligible for VIP Prize Draw on March 26, 2020. The draws for the Loyalty Prizes and VIP Prize will take place at noon Mountain Standard Time at the Grand Prize Showhome, 15201 Dinosaur Ridge Road, Morrison, Colorado. The winning ticket for the Loyalty Prizes and VIP Prize draws will be re-entered for all remaining draws and therefore a ticket purchaser or holder could possibly win more than one prize.

****Draw Scenario 2**

In the event that all tickets are sold by the Early Bird Prize Deadline of midnight Mountain Standard Time, April 9, 2020, then all remaining draws would be conducted on April 22, 2020, at noon Mountain Standard Time at the Grand Prize Showhome, 15201 Dinosaur Ridge Road, Morrison, Colorado. The first draw would be for the Early Bird Prize (see "Prize Claim" section below for more information on the Early Bird Prize). This would be followed by draws for all remaining prizes starting with the lowest valued contracted prize and ending with the most valuable contracted prize (the Grand Prize Showhome). Winning tickets for all draws will be re-entered for all remaining draws, and therefore a ticket purchaser or holder could possibly win more than one prize.

*****Draw Scenario 3**

In the event that tickets remain for sale after the Early Bird Prize Deadline of midnight Mountain Standard Time, April 9, 2020, then only the Early Bird Prize draw would be made on April 22, 2020, at noon Mountain Standard Time at the Grand Prize Showhome, 15201 Dinosaur Ridge Road, Morrison, Colorado. The winning ticket of the Early Bird Prize draw will be reentered for all remaining draws.

The Final Deadline for ticket sales is midnight Mountain Standard Time, May 1, 2020. The remaining draws would then be conducted starting with the lowest valued prize and ending with the most valuable prize on May 14, 2020 at noon Mountain Standard Time at the Grand Prize Showhome, 15201 Dinosaur Ridge Road, Morrison, Colorado.

The Games Manager will conduct all prize draws. All prizes will be drawn randomly in a manner licensed by the Colorado Secretary of State. Purchasers are not required to be present during any draws in order to win prizes. Winning tickets for all draws will be reentered for all remaining draws, and therefore a ticket purchaser or holder could possibly win more than one prize.
